Entries open for the Registered Master Builders Carters 2007 Apprentice of the Year Competition

The Registered Master Builders 2007 Apprentice of the Year competition, in association with Carters aims to recognise excellence among carpentry apprentices and raise awareness of careers in the building and construction industry.

The competition is a joint initiative run by the Registered Master Builders Federation (RMBF), principal sponsor Carters and supporting sponsors the Building and Construction Industry Training Organisation (BCITO) and new supporting sponsor the Department of Building and Housing (DBH).

This year the awards have been expanded to 10 regional competitions across the country and a new National Apprentice of the Year title has been introduced.
