BConstructive programme in schools

In November last year the BConstructive programme was successfully launched after the conclusion of the 2007 pilot programme.

BConstructive is a hands-on programme aimed at Year 11 and 12 high school students which has been developed by the Built Environment Training Alliance, a group of allied industry training organisations (ITO's) in the building and construction industry.

The high level of interest shown during the pilot has continued into 2008 with 260 schools to date registering their interest in the programme online via the website www.bconstructive.co.nz.

Many of these schools are set to deliver the Level 1 National Certificate qualification this year and others are busy preparing to implement the Level 1 and 2 qualifications going forward into 2009.
