### **BCITO 2007 Annual Report**

In our 2007 Annual Report the BCITO celebrates the achievements and results of the past year and recognises the input and support of all those involved in industry training.

Those results come from the combined efforts and support of our apprentices, their families, employers and workmates.

Achievements in 2007 included;

- Over 9,000 apprentices registered in training with the BCITO
- 1,324 qualifications achieved during 2007
- 90 training advisors making site visits across the country
- Working with 20 training providers and polytechnics in 28 locations to implement a streamlined off job training programme
- Annual customer satisfaction survey found 81% of BCITO apprentices were happy or very happy with their apprenticeships.
